The Complainant also went to the Manager's room where he saw him talking over telephone with Dr. Pratap Singh, General Secretary of the Prabandhak Committee, and its President, Shri Surendrajit Singh Ahluwalia. It was also alleged that Shri Surendrajit Singh Ahluwalia, who was earlier a central government Minister and a wealthy person, was sending threats to him."
